## **RULES**

**(Please read ALL rules carefully)**

1. Intended for amateur photographers only, an amateur being one who earns less than half his/her income as a photographer. Persons 18 years of age or younger will be judged separately, unless the entrants state a preference to have their images judged with the Adult Class Categories. Please read the rules for 18 and under on page 2 carefully, as they have been changed this year to include two separate age ranges.
2. Registration forms, fees (\$10.00 per Adult, \$5.00 per High School or Youth), and photo tickets should be included with photographs, either by mail or in person. Mailed photos should be sent to: **PHOTO CONTEST 2009, C/O BANGOR CIVIC CENTER, 100 DUTTON STREET, BANGOR, MAINE, 04401.**
3. Entries will be limited to one black & white and one color print in each adult category; two prints may be entered per 18 year old and under category only. Prints may be prepared using either a film or digital photographic process. You may not use the same image in more than one format; e.g. you cannot use the same beautiful flower close-up in color prints and B&W prints.
4. Image Manipulation—The Experimental category has been eliminated this year. Instead, the following rules regarding image manipulation will apply:
  - a. Color or B&W prints in all categories **EXCEPT** Nature may include any additions, modifications or manipulations, as long as they are the original work of the maker.
  - b. Nature images may not show the "hand of man" nor contain artificially produced hybrid plants or animals, mounted specimens or obviously set arrangements. Any form of manipulation that alters the truth of the photographic statement is ineligible. Limited manipulations may include resizing, cropping, selective lightening or darkening and restoration of the original color of the scene. No special effect filters can be applied. Any sharpening must appear natural.
5. Prints (image area) must be 5 inches by 7 inches or larger, but NOT larger than 16 inches by 20 inches, including matte. Images must be mounted on a backing, either matte board, foam core, or other rigid backing. No construction paper or likeness. No frames.
6. Any photograph which is determined by the committee or judges to not conform to the category entered will be moved into a more appropriate category for judging, unless this causes the entrant to exceed the number of prints allowed in that category. If there is no category available, the image will be disqualified.
7. Pictures entered in a previous Photo Contest at the Bangor State Fair will not be accepted and will be disqualified.
8. Decisions of the judges will be final and deviation from the above rules will automatically disqualify your entries.
9. The following information **must** be on the reverse of each entry: the entrant's name, address, phone number, the category (see Adult Class Categories or 18 and Under Categories on the next page), and the location where the photo was taken. Please include a title for the image. There can be NO writing or anything else added to the front of the print which might influence or distract the judges. Complete the Bangor State Fair Photo Contest Registration Form and the Photo Tickets for your prints prior to delivery to the Bangor Civic Center. Attach the photo tickets to your prints (one for each print) per the instructions included with the registration form.
10. Pictures mailed to Photo Contest 2009 must be received no later than 4:00 PM, Friday, July 24, 2009. Include registration form, fee and photo ticket(s) with photos. Entries to be returned by mail to you

must be MAIL READY (proper container, stamps, etc.). If you choose not to mail prints, club members will be available at the Bangor Civic Center, 100 Dutton Street, Bangor, on Monday, July 27th, 5:30 PM to 7:30 PM to accept prints.

11. All photos must be removed from the Civic Center on Monday, August 10, from 5:30 PM to 7:30 PM. Arrangements must be made with the Eastern Maine Camera Club if you are not able to collect your entries during this time. **ALL DECISIONS OF THE CONTEST COMMITTEE AND JUDGES WILL BE FINAL. ALL PHOTOGRAPHS WILL BE GIVEN REASONABLE CARE. THE COMMITTEE OR BANGOR STATE FAIR CANNOT BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR LOST OR DAMAGED PHOTOS, OR PHOTOS NOT PICKED UP WITHIN 30 DAYS.**

**ADULT CLASS CATEGORIES (Over 18 years old):**

**(Note: One Black & White plus one Color print per category. No nudes in any category.)**

1. Flowers
2. People
3. Children
4. Scenic
5. Animals
6. Nature—the “hand of man” cannot be evident in the picture.
7. Open—Any subject matter in good taste.
8. Maine—Photos that symbolize Maine and that were taken in Maine.
9. Up Close—Extreme close-ups, as in macro photography.
10. Special Open Category—Only for photographers who have never won 1st, 2nd or 3rd place in a previous Bangor State Fair Photo Contest.

Prize money and ribbons in all of the above categories include: First Place, \$40.00; Second Place, \$25.00; Third Place, \$15.00; Ribbons only will be awarded for Honorable Mention.

**18 YEARS OLD AND UNDER CATEGORIES:**

**(Note: Two Black & White plus two Color prints per category. No nudes in any category.)**

**This year there are two separate age ranges for the 18 and under categories:**

- **High School** (ages 14 through 18)
- **Youth** (ages 13 and under)

Please indicate on your registration form which age range you are entering in. If you are 18 or under, but choose to compete as an Adult, you may not enter in either the High School or Youth categories at the same time. Also, if you are under 14, you may choose to compete in the High School category, but you may not compete in the Youth category at the same time. The photo categories for both age ranges are as follows:

1. Open (any subject matter in good taste)
2. Maine—Photos that symbolize Maine and that were taken in Maine.

Prize money and ribbons in both of the 18 and under categories include: First Place, \$20.00; Second Place, \$15.00; Third Place, \$10.00; Ribbons only for Honorable Mention.

**BEST IN SHOW:**

ADULT CLASS: \$150.00 each for color and black & white

HIGH SCHOOL: \$50.00 (One award in either color or black & white.)

YOUTH CLASS: \$50.00 (One award in either color or black & white.)

The contest committee reserves the right not to award ribbons and premiums to photos deemed not worthy by the judges, or to combine categories when numbers of entries are insufficient.

**Prize money will be forfeited if any print is removed from display before Mon, August 10th.**



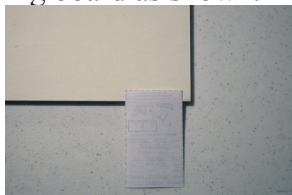

Submit this form, along with the photo(s), fee and Photo Ticket(s) from the Photo Ticket forms at the same time. Packages must be received at the address above no later than 4:00 PM, Friday July 24, 2009, or may be dropped off in person on Monday, July 27<sup>th</sup> 2009 from 5:30 PM to 7:30 PM at the Bangor Civic Center. Instructions for attaching the Photo Tickets are shown below.

1. Fill out a Photo Ticket for each entry.
2. Do not write in the "Seq. Num." or "Awards" boxes. These are for the committee use only.
3. Check off the appropriate box for Adult/Youth and Color/BW
4. Place the mounted photo face down.
5. Write your name, address, phone, category, and location photo was taken on the back of the mounting board in case the Photo Ticket comes off.
6. Place the Photo Ticket face down in the lower right hand corner of the mounting board. Align the ticket so that it hangs below the mounting board as shown.



7. Tape the top of the ticket to the mounting board as shown.



8. Fold the ticket up at the dotted line.



9. Use a post it note or small piece of tape to temporarily hold the ticket up for judging.



10. When the committee hangs the photo for display after the judging the ticket will be released so that it hangs below the mounting board identifying the photographer.
